A further **18 credits** are to be covered, as a matter of student choice, by any graduate course(s) offered by the University irrespective of the language of instruction (including any of the above courses if not already chosen).

A period of **work placement (stage)**, secured on students' own initiative (**6 credits**). N.B. The University does not itself provide work placements for students. Rather, work placements are sought out by students on their own initiative and are then recognized by the University with credits. Efforts by students to secure work placements are facilitated by conventions between the University of Pavia and specific institutions. Subject to approval, students may apply independently for an internship with some alternative organization. In the light of a successful application, the University will then aim to establish the necessary official convention between the University and the organization in question.

### **A Thesis (6 credits).**
